*Program Description:* The State Code of Conduct sets forth specific ethical standards to guide the conduct of State employees, officers, and officials. It also discusses the role of the State Public Integrity Commission in issuing advisory opinions on whether certain conduct is prohibited, granting waivers to specific prohibitions where permitted, and investigating complaints of unethical conduct.
